Waiver and Release

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in consideration for permission to use the facilities, you will be expressly assuming the risk and liability and waiving and releasing all claims for injuries, damages, or loss which you or your dog might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with use of these facilities and the surrounding areas.

I herby acknowledge that I have voluntarily applied to participate and use with my dog(s), The Boneyard Dog Park and Off-Leash play areas owned and operated by the Town of Ossian. I understand that the act of unleashing my dog and being physically present within the parks necessarily involves risk of injury to me, persons that accompany me, other people using the park, my dog(s) and other dogs. I understand that the aforementioned risks are entirely my responsibility and I expressly assume that responsibility knowingly and voluntarily. When this Waiver and Release refers to my dog(s), it includes me whether or not I am the legal owner of the dog, since I am the person responsible for the dog while using the park.

I understand that the permit/license system is not established to guarantee that dogs in the park are safe or healthy. I also understand that dog activities are intended to provide fun and rewarding experience for a dog and its owner/handler. However, despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including death, to the dog, its owner/handler or other persons or animals. I further understand that dogs, irrespective of their training and usual past behavior or characteristics, may act or react unpredictably at times based upon instinct or circumstances, and that not all hazards and dangers associated with dog activities can be foreseen. I agree to assume the risk of any injury, to me, any individuals (including children) that may accompany me in the park, and my dog(s). I understand that this risk may result from fierce, aggressive, vicious, and dangerous dogs which may be present in the parks.

I further understand and assume the risk that not all dogs may have been vaccinated for distemper parvo, or rabies, all of which could result in injury to me, any individuals, (including children) accompanying me, and my dog(s). I also understand that there are certain inherent risks including the propensity of a dog to behave in dangerous ways. Additional risks include, but are not limited to: The inexperience of a dog owner/handler, the inability to predict a dog's reaction to sound, movement, objects, persons or other animals; dog fights, dog bites, and injuries to humans and other dogs; dog theft or unlawful capture; dogs escape over or under fences; plants in the area that may be poisonous to dogs or people; mosquitos ,ticks, chiggers, fleas or other insects may be present; and wild animals such as skunks, opossums, or stray dogs that could be present in and around the park, as well as all other circumstances inherent to dog(s) and/or outdoor activities. I knowingly and voluntarily accept responsibility for all of these risks for the privilege or use of The Boneyard Dog Park.

It is my understanding that no agents or employees of the Town of Ossian will supervise the park at any time and I therefore expressly assume responsibility for all risks associated with the park as well as fixtures and equipment that may be located there in an unsupervised manner.

By signing this Waiver and Release and using the park, I fully release and discharge the Town of Ossian and their employees and agents as well as any private citizen volunteers as park stewards which have been sanctioned by the Town from any claims, damages, rights of action, present or future, known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, resulting from, or arising out of, my use or intended use of the park. I fully and forever release and discharge the Town of Ossian and their employees and agents as well as any sanctioned volunteers from any and all negligent acts or omissions with regard to the park and intend to be legally bound by this Release. I assume sole responsibility for, and agree to indemnify and save harmless the Town of Ossian, their employees and agents and volunteers of each for any damages from bodily injury, death, or damage or loss to property including legal and expert witness fees caused by the previously described parties.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE AND UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. I HAVE ALSO RECEIVED A COPY OF THE DOG PARK AND OFF-LEASH AREA RULES AND REULATIONS AND AGREE BY AFIXING MY SIGNATURE BELOW TO COMPLY WITH THOSE RULES AND WILL ENDURE THEIR COMPLIANCE WHILE USING THE PARK. MY SIGNATURE CONFIRMS THAT I AMD ALSO NOT AWARE OF ANY INCEIDENTS IN WHICH MY DOG HAS SHOWN AGGRESSION, FIGHTING, OR BITING BEHAVIOR TOWARDS OTHER ANIMALS OR PEOPLE.

The Boneyard Dog Park

Rules and Regulations

The Ossian Boneyard Dog Park is opened from dawn to dusk for registered key holders only. Under no circumstances will the park be in use before 7 am or after 10 pm. The maximum number of dogs allowed in the park area at any given time is 15. Please limit your visit to one hour during times of peak use.

- A dog park membership is required to use this facility. Registration information is available at Ossian Town Hall.
- Always keep and eye on your dog. Never leave your dog unattended
- Always clean up after your dog. It's the law. Containers are available in the park for this purpose. Please bring your own bags.
- Female dogs in season are not permitted in the playground and should not be brought to the park
- Dogs, Owners, and users creating a disturbance or violating rules must leave the playground if requested by law
 enforcement personnel, town personnel, or other designated agents. Misuse of the park or allowing
 nonregistered pet in will cause the forfeiture of your key and no refund will be issued. Individuals failing to
 comply with the posted rules are subject to citation, expulsion or arrest, as well as dog(s) impoundment.
- Excessive barking in prohibited
- No more than three (3) dogs per handler are allowed at a time
- Puppies under four (4) months of age are not permitted in the playground. Puppies are not fully vaccinated, and are vulnerable to disease and injury
- Dog handlers must be 16 years of age or older. Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- Dogs may not be left unattended or out sight range or voice command.
- Dogs must be on a leash until safely inside the playground enclosure (fence)
- Please remove pinch (prong) collars and spike collars from dogs before entering the park, other dogs can be injured while playing.
- No animals other than dogs are permitted in the dog park. No wolves or wolf hybrids allowed.
- Do not bring glass containers to the facility.
- Do not bring food (people food, dog food, or dog treats) into the playground. Many owners do not feed treats and some dogs may be allergic. Food may also cause aggression.
- No tobacco products in or around the park.
- Maintenance needs of the site will vary based on weather and use. You are asked to vacate the playground during maintenance activities.
- Dogs should receive year-round heartworm prevention treatment.
- Professional dog trainers shall not use the park to conduct their business
- Do not open the outside gate if the inside gate is open
- Owners must keep their dog(s) leash on their person at all times to be able to quickly regain control over their dog
- A dog bite to a human or another animal must be reported. The biting animal will be quarantined for ten days to ensure it is healthy and does not pose a rabies risk. If the bite happens while indie the Boneyard fend playground the dog will be considered legally restrained at the time of the bite. If a bite happens while at the park:
- Immediately secure the biting dog and the victim dog. Leash them and keep separated.
- Any wounds should be washed immediately.
- Owners of dogs involved should exchange names, address, and telephone numbers
- Local law enforcement should be called to take a bit report and enact quarantine.
- Owners should then take their dog(s) home or to a veterinarian for necessary medical care. If a bite has occurred to a person, consult physician
